Kitchen Duties

The following information should help your school to organize volunteers and food for the kitchen at our competitions:

- Beginning 1/2 hour before the start of the competition, volunteers will be needed to serve coffee and food to anyone wanting refreshments. We suggest that you try to have volunteers scheduled until at least 3 p.m.
- The last volunteers are asked to help clean up.
- High school students can collect volunteer hours for their community involvement requirements for graduation. Have them bring their form with them for me to sign at the end of their shift.

The lists below will remind you of what will be supplied by the OHDA and what your school is asked to provide. Also, your school is responsible for providing and serving lunch for the judge.

Items supplied by the OHDA:

1. Dish soap and cleaner
2. Tea bags
3. Coffee
4. Hot chocolate
5. Milk & cream for coffee/tea
6. Sugar, Splenda
7. Water
8. Pop
9. Pogo's
10. Hot dogs, buns
11. Doughnuts
12. Pizza
13. Price lists, signs
14. Napkins
15. Cutlery
16. Paper plates, cups
17. Coffee urns and kettle

Items that we ask your school to supply:

1. One tray (for judge's lunch).
2. Garbage bags (at least two)
3. 1 roll of paper towels (eg. for drying coffee urns)
4. Baked goods - individually wrapped
5. Other snack foods (eg. pudding, yogurt)
6. Fruit – either whole fruit, or fruit salad, individually wrapped.
7. Vegetables and dip - individually wrapped
8. Crackers and cheese - individually wrapped
9. Sandwiches - each sandwich individually wrapped
10. Ketchup, mustard and relish
